Journey time approximately 60 minutes from Vienna International Airport by public transport:

- **By metropolitan railway ("Schnellbahn")**
Take the S7 line to Wien Mitte, then change to the westbound U4 (green) underground line and alight at Schönbrunn

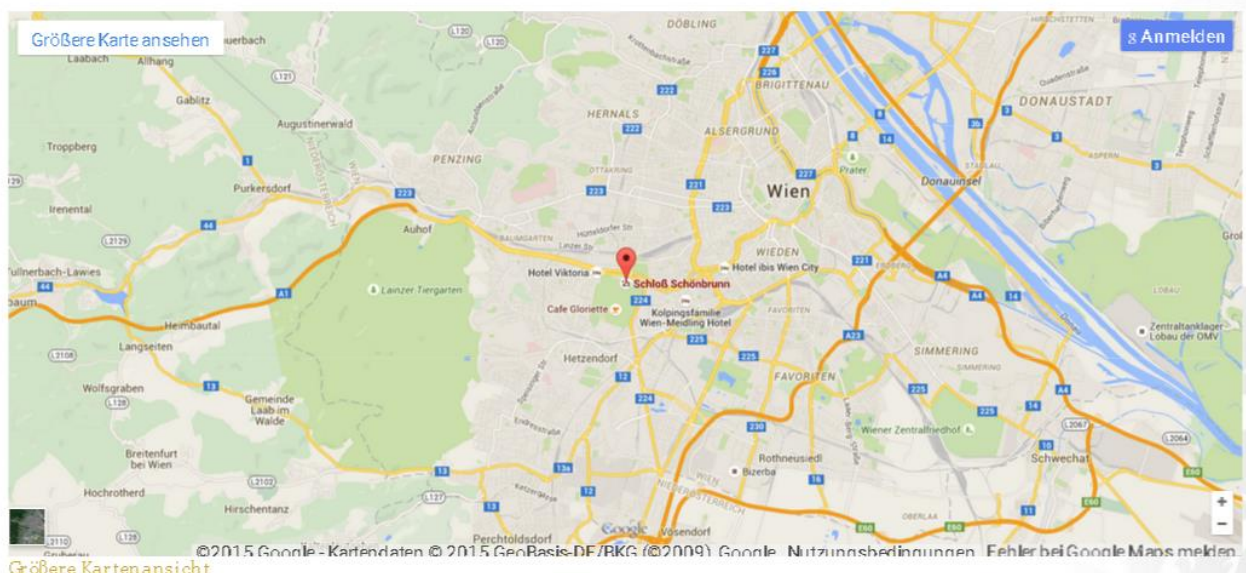

Arriving by car Parking space is available.

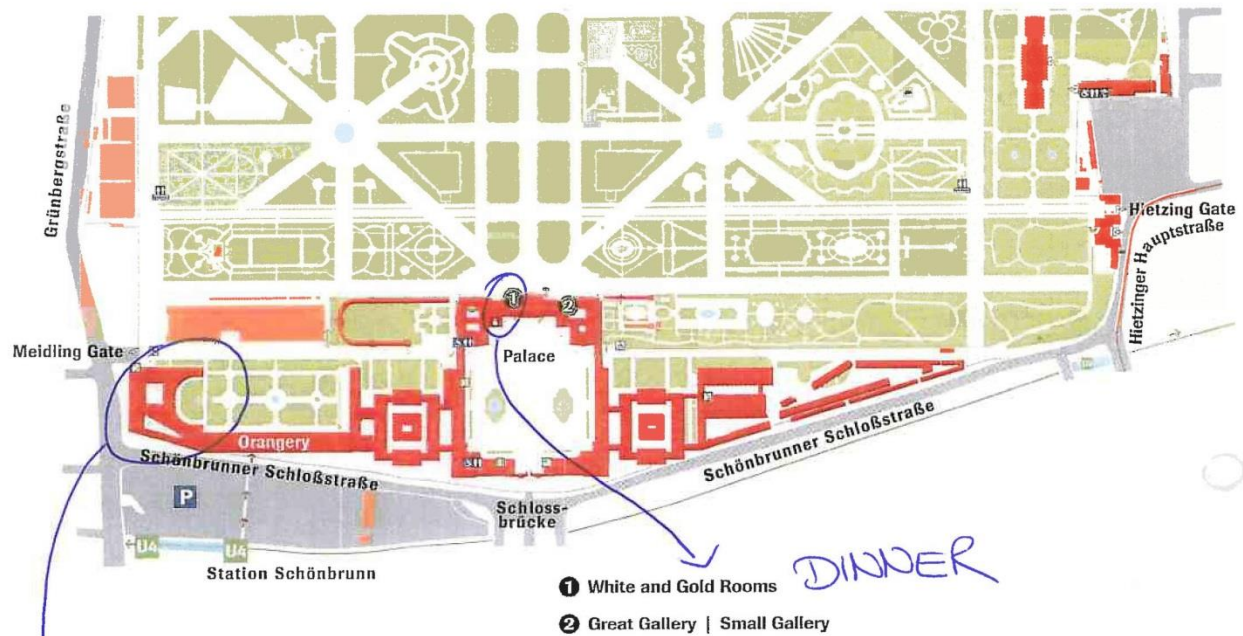
